The Political Economy of Mental Illness in South Africa André J van Rensburg, 2021-02-17 The book describes key socio political reforms that helped shape post apartheid South Africa's mental health system. of the study show that security concerns of old age have yet to get adequate attention from family members society and government The elderly people have mixed opinions on their age few consider that old age has brought lots of knowledge experience and skills so they are resourceful whereas othersassert themselvesas utterly dependent on family and helpless Interestingly it also reveals that longevity has provided an opportunity to ponder upon life and death and they tend to chase more spiritual gatherings and functions This study also reveals the mounting generational gaps emerging in the families
