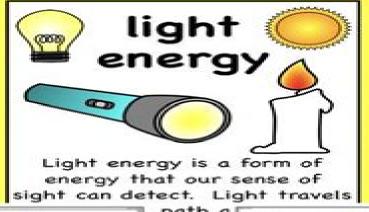

Lesson 4: Light Energy

4-PS3-2. Make observations to provide evidence that energy can be transferred from place to place by sound, light, heat, and electric currents

- Ask students to brainstorm again about what they know about light energy.
 - Mopefully they will know that light is a form of energy that lefts us see, if travels in a straight line, and that light energy starts with the sun.

Place out the worksheet: Investigating Light

You can have shudents look at the vocabulary words and try and complete the panagraph with a partner or in a small group by lightly recording their answers before the video to get an idea of their prior knowledge.

- Explore how light energy can be transferred to make things move. You will need a strong light like a clamp on light and small solar objects.
 - You can get a clamp on light for around \$8 at Lowes etc. Amazon sells little solar cars for \$.9%, and solar grasshoppers for \$2.99 (as of May 2018).

Place one of the solar objects under the clamp on light. Turn it on and watch your object move.
