

Captain Cook's Landing at Botany Bay

Account of Captain James Cook

Sunday 19th April 1770

Almost a week had passed since Lieutenant Hicks shouted 'land ahoy' and furnished our discovery of the east coast of New Holland.

Since then, we have sailed the Endeavour steadily northwards, keeping land in sight all the while. We have been kept busy mapping the coastline of this new and mysterious land.

On the morning of Sunday 19th April, we reached a place of great interest. It was a wide but shallow inlet, the immediately dropped anchor off a low headland covered with sand dunes. The great number of shipwrecks caught that morning prompted me to rather uncreatively name this place 'Shipwreck Harbour'.

Around lunchtime we lifted anchor and sailed the Endeavour into the inlet. On either headland, we saw natives.

Soon after we dropped anchor again, a number of fellow sailors and myself set out in a rowboat to investigate. As we drifted toward the shore I said to sailor Isaac Smith, 'Jump out, Isaac,' thus making him the first European to set foot on the jilted east coast of New Holland. We all went followed and waded through the shallow, warm water to the shore.



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After they had waded across there from a group of us in a boat and the first one looking about, they saw an old man, the other a younger fellow. We asked them why they could not accept them. Perhaps they had misunderstood what we had said. Doubtless, one of my men then went up.

A week, including the night, they did not even look at a number of other men they spent at us - all looking friendly. I am quite sure over their heads and shoulders.

Of course, we found only a small number of shells to communicate with the group, and returned to our boat.

It is a wonderful day. The next day the weather permitted our explorations up the east coast of the shipwreck we might find!

NRC issued the report *Understanding Child Abuse and Neglect* which provided an overview of the research on child abuse and neglect. *New Directions in Child Abuse and Neglect Research* updates the 1993 report and provides new recommendations to respond to this public health challenge. According to this report, while there has been great progress in child abuse and neglect research, a coordinated national research infrastructure with high level federal support needs to be established and implemented immediately. *New Directions in Child Abuse and Neglect Research* recommends an actionable framework to guide and support future child abuse and neglect research. This report calls for a comprehensive multidisciplinary approach to child abuse and neglect research that examines factors related to both children and adults across physical, mental, and behavioral health domains, including those in child welfare, economic support, criminal justice, education, and health care systems, and assesses the needs of a variety of subpopulations. It should also clarify the causal pathways related to child abuse and neglect and more importantly, assess efforts to interrupt these pathways. *New Directions in Child Abuse and Neglect Research* identifies four areas to look to in developing a coordinated research enterprise: a national strategic plan, a national surveillance system, a new generation of researchers, and changes in the federal and state programmatic and policy response.

Non-Fiction for the Literacy Hour Guy Merchant, Huw Thomas, 2014-04-08. Stress, Trauma, and Children's Memory Development Mark L. Howe, Gail S. Goodman, Dante Cicchetti, 2008-04-10. Few questions in psychology have generated as much debate as those concerning the impact of childhood trauma on memory. A lack of scientific research to constrain theory has helped fuel arguments about whether childhood trauma leads to deficits that result in conditions such as false memory or lost memory, and whether neurohormonal changes that are correlated with childhood trauma can be associated with changes in memory. Scientists have also struggled with more theoretical concerns, such as how to conceptualize and measure distress and other negative emotions in terms of, for example, discrete emotions, physiological response, and observer ratings. To answer these questions, Mark L. Howe, Gail Goodman, and Dante Cicchetti have brought together the most current and innovative neurobiological, cognitive, clinical, and

legal research on stress and memory development This research examines the effects of early stressful and traumatic experiences on the development of memory in childhood and elucidates how early trauma is related to other measures of cognitive and clinical functioning in childhood It also goes beyond childhood to both explore the long term impact of stressful and traumatic experiences on the entire course of normal memory development and determine the longevity of trauma memories that are formed early in life Stress Trauma and Children s Memory Development will be a valuable resource for anyone interested in early experience childhood trauma and memory research
