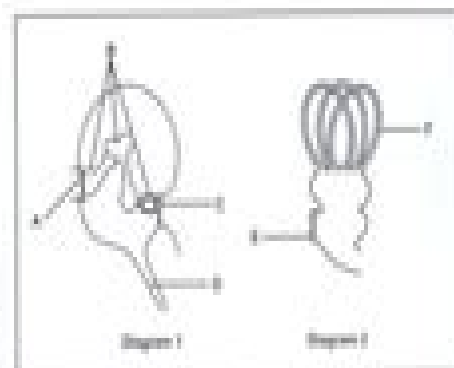

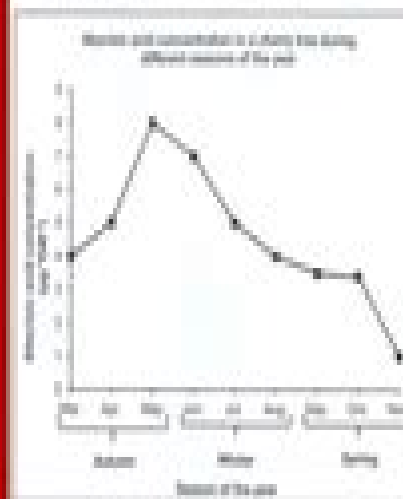

The Life and Work of General Andrew J. Goodpaster C.
